General options considered:

- Debt: Option 2 The least painful way of meeting the \$2.5m shortfall
- Stormwater: Option 1 Not sure why Waihi Beach has special funding for stormwater
- Waihi Beach Promotion: Option 1 or 2 This is for Waihi Beach ratepayers to decide
- Cycleway: Option 3 Best and Fairest approach by the Council
- Library (KK): Option 2 Again really for KK to decide. Not opposed to Option 3
- Heritage Museum: Option C Agree the District needs more Museums. Maketu one day.

Pukehina Beach inclusions to be discussed at a Council Hearing:

- Tsunami Warning Systems
- Kerb and channel – beachside of Pukehina Parade and Costello Crescent
- Rubbish disposal options - Cooks Beach has bags in steel netting cages
- Walkway Funding and Development
- Fishing pier/wharf pontoon by boat ramp – apparently done in other places – council has plans and were enthusiastic
- Flood Light at Boat Ramp – under control, thanks for prompt service.
- Entrance from SH from Te Puke into to Pukehina Beach Road – realignment for safety and beautification of entrance to Pukehina Beach – discussed with Alex Finn (WBOPDC Roading)
- Parks - More Pohutukawa Trees
- Shade Cloth over childrens playgrounds
- Octopus logo - usage in our area – valuing diversity and heritage recognition etc
- Parking at Surf Club
- Civil Defence signage – exit to Pongakawa
- Hopper Bus service Whakatane/Tauranga to visit Pukehina 1 day per week
